

Geoff Regan







Rain, Wind, and Wild Umbrellas: A Garden Giveaway to Remember!

It all began with a tiny drizzle – nothing dramatic – as the Blandford Environment Committee gathered at the Community Centre on Saturday, May 10th. Spirits were high. Tents were coming out. So were the head-scratches and "how-does-this-thing-go-up" moments. Tables were set, plants proudly arranged, and seeds tucked safely into the driest corner we could find. It was all looking good. And then... Mother Nature decided to test us.

First came the wind. Then the rain. Buckets of it. Water collected in the middle of our "sunscreen" tent. One brave soul hoisted a beach umbrella in the centre to stop the tent from becoming a swimming pool – which caused mini tidal waves to pour off the sides. Puddles snuck in from every direction, soaking everything beneath the shelter. At the soggiest moment, the umbrella was perched on a table in a stand, heroically holding up the middle of the tent. Eventually, even the bravest of us knew it was time. We called it a day at noon (an hour early), and with the help of cheerful friends and family, we packed it all up. The last tent, soaking wet, was taken away to be dried on a sunny day... someday.

So, what did we learn? Next year, we're renting the Lodge Room. Even if the forecast says "tropical beach weather." No more tents in early May. Ever. Let's spread the word better – and maybe invite local garden clubs to join the fun. Despite it all, seeds and plants were shared. Community was built.
